Complete the game and return the game piece to the Info Booth to receive a prize for completing the game. Everyone who plays the game will win a prize. The grand prize winner will be determined after the Fair and your prize will be mailed to you.

Collect your Fun Buttons!!

Start collecting your FUN BUTTONS now. Go to the Fair Restaurant or Small Animal Barn to purchase your FUN BUTTON bracelet for \$1.00. Then go to the different departments, find the person with the "Fun Button ASK ME RIBBON" and tell them you are there to collect a FUN BUTTON. They will ask you a question and you have to answer the question correctly. The answer will be somewhere in that department. Look around the department for the answer and then go back and tell them the answer to receive your FUN BUTTON. Complete instructions will be in the Fair Restaurant and on the kiosks.
